- What do you think about ____? (something going on)

Follow-Up Questions

- Why do you say that?
- Really! What do you mean by that?
- Tell me more about that.
- What happened after that?
- What did you do about that?
- Why do you think that is?
- How did that make you feel?
- What do you think should happen instead?
- How has that affected you and your family?
